

ERG RAFFLE FUNDRAISER

The ERG Raffle fundraiser is held in December. Rowers sell raffle tickets for a chance to win a Concept II ("ERG") rowing exercise machine. Retail price of the ERG rower is approximately \$800.

Details about the program for each year will be communicated by E-Mail and on the SC-Crew.org website.

General information given below is based on previous years:

- Each rower is required to pick up a packet on the day that they become available. Packets contain raffle tickets, an information sheet describing the rowing machine, and instructions for selling the tickets.
- Each rower is responsible for selling a minimum of two tickets. This will ensure that SC Crew will be able to cover the purchase cost of the ERG rower.
- Rowers are urged to sell tickets to family members, friends, and neighbors. Tickets have been \$5.00 each in previous years. Rowers should have no problem selling tickets at this price.
- 100% of proceeds from tickets sold by individual rowers are credited against the rower's fundraising commitment.
- The "end date" will be communicated to rowers. All rowers are required to turn in ALL unsold tickets, money, and ticket stubs for tickets which were sold.
- The drawing is held approximately two days after the "end date". The winner will be notified by telephone and arrangements will be made to have the ERG rower delivered to the winner's house before December 25.

- In addition to the above, arrangements will be made with local grocery stores (e.g. Lorton Giant on Rte 123 and Shoppers on Market Square Drive) to allow us to sell tickets at their doors two consecutive weekends.
- Rowers and parents are needed to volunteer to man the positions on the days and times that the doors are offered to SC Crew.
- Gross proceeds from all ticket sales at the groceries are 100% apportioned out as credits to individual rower's fundraising commitment based on their participation in the grocery store ticket sales. Hours worked by family members (parents and siblings) count towards the rower's share.
