Chaperone Duties

- 1 Chaperones are in charge of the rowers when they are not at the river.
- 2 Chaperones are required to be in close proximity to the rowers at all times. Including meals, hotel and bus. Expected to stay at the regatta the entire time the team is there, but not required to maintain headcount at the river until the bus returns. Responsible for having them assemble at designated times and locations to get ready for bus travel, etc.
- 3 Evening at the hotel- minimum of 1 Chaperone present in the hallway to ensure rowers are quiet and orderly at least until midnight.
- 4 Head count at 9:30 pm to make sure rowers are back in assigned rooms.
- 5 Check designated rooms for headcount in the morning and ensure rowers are up.
- 6 One chaperone will be the lead, hopefully a volunteer.
- 7 If a rower comes out of his/her room for ANY reason after 9:30 pm, a coach needs to be notified immediately. If any issue comes up, a coach needs to be notified immediately.
